## **PLANTING and CARING FOR your clematis**

### **Planting**

Before planting soak your new clematis for 10 minutes in a bucket of water, ensuring that the plant absorbs enough water. Plant the clematis in a planting hole one spade deep and one spade wide. Plant the clematis at least 5 cm deeper than the height of the plant in the pot. A clematis needs moist well drained soil. You can use rose soil or you can combine potting soil with your own soil.

### **Fertilizing**

Fertilize your clematis at the end of the winter with well rotted organic manure. From the beginning of the spring till the end of the summer apply liquid fertilizer several times. Before and during flowering, give the clematis plenty of water in order to avoid clematis wilt. This is particularly important for the large flowering hybrids.

### **Pruning**

The type of pruning depends upon the time of year in which the clematis flowers. When it comes to pruning, clematis can be divided into three groups. For more detailed information see the other side.

*The first year prune every type of newly purchased clematis back to 30 cm above the ground (just above two healthy buds).*

**1** This type of clematis flowers on stems from the previous year. Pruning is only necessary for the weak and dead wood. If the clematis has grown too large it can be pruned, but not until after it has flowered.

**2** This type of clematis flowers best on old stems, and less well on young stems. Prune weak and dead wood in February, beginning of March. After flowering prune lightly.

**3** This type of clematis flowers on stems from the same year. Prune this clematis at the end of February and beginning of March back to approximately 50 cm above the ground. Some sorts die off at ground level. Prune these back to 5 cm.
